against proposed waste plant**

On Sunday 8 July 2012, BBC Young Musician finalist and Pianist, Sam Haywood will perform with the award winning Galitzin Chamber Ensemble with all proceeds going to the Pinkham Way Alliance Campaign. The Pinkham Way Alliance is a local campaign actively opposing the 300,000 tonne a year waste processing plant proposed by The North London Waste Authority (NLWA), on a site of natural habitat, adjoining Muswell Hill Golf Course.

Described as having "passionate flair, a warm touch and sparkling clarity" Sam Haywood has a renowned international reputation and performing with locally raised musician family Joe and Ken Ichinose and their sister Miya and the talented American violinist, Shana Douglas, will make this a concert not to be missed.

Pinkham Way Alliance member and local resident, Sakina Chenot said: "There's now a real risk that the North London Waste Authority will try and push forward the planning application for a massive facility at Pinkham Way. With the huge momentum behind them to secure this site, it is of crucial importance that we continue to raise money to pay for the vital legal advice that we need to fight their plans."
